PRESENTATIONS	<p>Welcome Remarks/Dept Announcements – Doug Ziedonis, MD, MPH, Professor and Chairman</p> <p>1) Medical Center changes – In keeping with Medical Center's main priority of integrative services, Dr. Ziedonis discussed the planned change in our footprint across the campus as well as the anticipated changes in training to increase integration into primary care. Specific changes affecting our Department of Psychiatry will be forthcoming. Dr. Ziedonis asks all to consider how we can make improvements during this time of change. He discussed possibilities and recent examples of enhancements being made in the areas of residency and medical student education, diversity, mentoring and leadership.</p> <p>2) Name change – As announced at the recent Department of Mental Health's Center of Excellence conference, the Center for Mental Health Services Research and its Director, Dr. Carl Fulwiler, is excited about their name change to: SPARC – Systems and Psychosocial Advances Research Center effective yesterday, April 1st. Motivation for the name change includes better representation of the Center's complete portfolio including cutting-edge recovery-informed research, training, and systemic intervention. In addition, it is an acknowledgement of evolutionary changes in the field of mental health services and the diversification of the Center's body of work since 1993 and captures their "spark of innovation" sought after in their work.</p> <p>3) Psychiatry Idea Board - As UMMHC continues their nonstop strive for excellence and using Lean to provide the tools to lay the foundation of True North, the Idea System remains a top priority for our CEO, Dr. Eric Dickson. 	<p>4) ICD-10 Update – Ralph Seymour, MD, provided a brief overview on the transition to the use of ICD-10 from the ICD-9 system. Movement to the upgraded system will help all clinicians meet all regulatory requirements, assure appropriate reimbursement, and minimize impact on productivity while increasing diagnosis accuracy and decreasing processing and claims denial.
