PRESENTATIONS	1) Physician Payment Sunshine Act – John Randolph, Vice President & Chief Compliance Officer discussed the guidelines outlining the Physician Payments <a href="#">Sunshine Act</a> -- which went into effect on August 1, 2013 --	

	<p>requiring companies to report all payments to Health and Human Services (HHS) who must then post those payments on a user-friendly website. Last August, the process of capturing data was established. The database will go live on line effective September 30, 2014. Mr. Randolph discussed who is subject to reporting, what will be reported to CMS (Centers for Medicare/Medicaid Services), most commonly reported activities, and implications of the Sunshine Act.
