PRESENTATIONS	<p> UMass Memorial Policy on Teaching Physician Supervision</p> <p>John Randolph, spoke about the compliance issues that have come up related to the UMass Memorial policy on teaching physician supervision and the consequences and implications it will have on all departments henceforth. It is important as teaching physicians to be aware of the necessity for overseeing and supervising visits conducted by residents and the attendant documentation that reflect that activity.
