

Research Participants Needed



The Transition to Adoptive Parenthood Project is the first study to explore couples' experiences as they become adoptive parents for the first time. This study is being undertaken by Abbie Goldberg of the Psychology Department at Clark University, in an effort to better understand the challenges and supports that may be available to couples during this time. She is interviewing couples during the pre-adoption period, and then 3-4 months after the adoption, as part of this pioneering project.
