The Center for Health Policy and Research (CHPR) at the University of Massachusetts Medical School is seeking applicants for the position of Senior Biostatistician within the Research Unit. The mission of CHPR is to promote and conduct applied research, evaluation and education aimed at informing policy decisions that improve the health and well being of people served by public agencies.

The successful candidate will be responsible for designing and leading statistical analyses for a variety of health services and health policy studies, conducting independent research, scientific supervision of masters-level biostatisticians, providing statistical consultation to faculty and senior staff and collaborating with faculty in developing scientific proposals and in writing papers for peer-reviewed publication.

Qualifications include a Ph.D. in statistics, applied mathematics or a closely related discipline, a minimum of 5 years post doctoral experience in health services research or a similar health-related area, successful experience in preparing analysis plans for proposals submitted to the National Institutes of Health or similar funding sources, supervisory experience and good interpersonal skills.

Qualified candidates will receive a faculty appointment at the Associate Professor or Professor level and be involved in educational and other academic activities. A significant percentage of time will be funded by Commonwealth Medicine directly and reserved for consultation to faculty and staff of the Center.
