

**Michael Tutty, MHA**  
**Acting Director, OCP**

Michael Tutty is the Acting Director of the Office of Community Programs (OCP) at the Center for Health Policy and Research (CHPR) and an Instructor in the Department of Family Medicine and Community Health at the University of Massachusetts Medical School. In his role as the Acting Director of OCP, Mr. Tutty manages the day to day operations of OCP, including coordinating and overseeing all project work, and managing staff and financial budgets for the Office. Prior to that role, Mr. Tutty was the Director of Academic Services at CHPR where he managed educational linkages between CHPR and the medical school, managed internal grants and funding initiatives, and supported the development of new dissemination vehicles for CHPR's academic work. Previous to that position, Mr. Tutty was a Senior Project Director at CHPR. In that role, he led numerous engagements in health policy development, regulatory reporting, and program evaluations. Specifically, Mr. Tutty led engagements researching the disabled population who utilizes Medicaid, understanding the impact of policy changes on pharmaceutical utilization, and identifying Medicaid's role in supporting HIT adoption. Mr. Tutty areas of interest include health reform, community engagement, and pharmaceutical policy. Mr. Tutty teaches a community medicine clerkship in health policy.

Mr. Tutty's prior experience includes working at the Boston Consulting Group (BCG) where he spent five years as a Senior Analyst in their Health Care Practice Group. At BCG, he acted as primary healthcare expert for the North American sector responsible for monitoring and understanding pharmaceutical, biotechnology, hospital, and health insurance industries in order to make recommendations on appropriate consulting strategies. He advised consultants, managers, and vice presidents from North American and international offices on healthcare information, trends, and issues facing the United States and Canadian healthcare industry. Prior to BCG, he worked as a Senior Planning Analyst for Baystate Health System in Springfield. Mr. Tutty has a Master of Health Administration from Clark University/University of Massachusetts Medical School and is currently working on his PhD in Public Policy from the University of Massachusetts Boston.
