

FACULTY DISCLOSURE FORM

It is the policy of the University of Massachusetts Medical School (UMMS) to ensure balance, independence, objectivity and scientific rigor in all its individually sponsored or jointly sponsored continuing medical education programs. All faculty participating in UMMS-sponsored programs are expected to disclose to the audience any actual or potential conflict(s) of interest that may have a direct bearing on the subject matter of the CME program. This pertains to relationships with pharmaceutical companies, biomedical device manufacturers, or other commercial organizations whose products or services are related to the subject matter being presented. The intent of this policy is not to prevent a speaker with a conflict of interest from making a presentation. It is merely intended that any potential conflict should be identified openly so that the learner may make his/her own judgment about the presentation with full disclosure of the facts. It remains for the audience to determine whether the speaker's outside interests may reflect a possible bias.
