Procedure following Blood/Body Fluid Exposure

If you are exposed to blood, visibly bloody fluids, or other body fluids (e.g. cerebrospinal, synovial, peritoneal, pleural, amniotic, semen, vaginal secretions) from a needlestick/ cut or splash to eyes, mouth, nose, or open cut:

WHAT TO DO:

1. **Immediately** stop the procedure (if you are doing one) & notify supervisor.
2. Gently bleed, wash, and flush affected area with soap & water (only water for eye)
3. Page **BUGS beeper: Internal: 77-BUGS (2847) / External: 508-426-1105**
4. Obtain initial evaluation. –DO NOT DELAY - It is important to be evaluated within 2 hours of exposure. You may need immediate treatment.

 - If after hours, go to the Emergency Department - DO NOT go to Student Health for any immediate attention for a needlestick/body fluid exposure.
 - At all other sites, students should follow protocol @ that site for initial treatment and follow-up will be provided through Student Health.
5. Notify clerkship director and complete incident report (avail. in each dept.) bring to Student Health.
 6. All students with exposures will go to Student Health (1st fl Benedict Bldg) for follow-up after initial visit in the ER or with Employee Health.

Caring for Patients on Airborne Precautions

If assisting in the care of a patient in a neg. pressure room or on respiratory precautions. (e.g. TB, SARS), you **MUST** be wearing a fit tested respirator such as a NIOSH-approved N95 respirator **before** entering a patient's room.

*No student will be allowed to start 3rd year until they have cleared or exempted from the N-95 fitting requirement with Student Health (508-334-8464).
