Friday, October 27, 2006

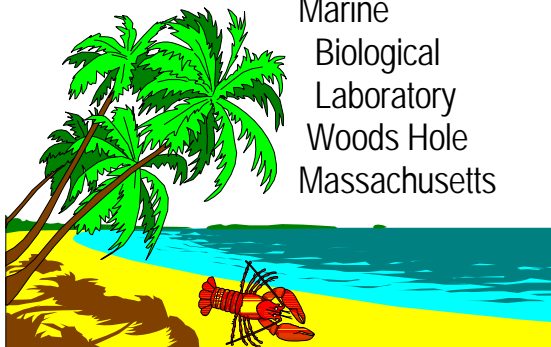
