

Demographics Cont.

Most common health issues:

- Hypertension
- Diabetes
- Fever and upper respiratory infection
- Stomach pain (most common complaint)
- Fungal skin infections and wounds

Issues affecting access:

Cost of transportation, lack of health insurance, lack of proper Dominican Republic documentation, resource deficit in the public health system.

Fundación Enciende Una Luz (Light A Candle Mission, LAC) is a nonprofit organization that provides health education initiatives such as a hypertension clinic program to Bateys 18 & 22

Population: Underserved communities in Southeastern Dominican Republic

- Health Education
- Health Promotion
- Empowerment Opportunities

Success: Medication to Bateys, Health Education

Challenges: Every 3 Months, Not at every Batey, Limited HTN Medication



Health Advocacy

Health Promoters document blood pressure, point person for acute care, and informs community of LAC

Population: Batey 18 and 22

Success: Local support, documentation of community needs, and dependable source of health information

Challenges: Addressing limited medications and pressure from the community, Understaffed, Patient Relocation



Health Advocacy

Good Samaritan Hospital was founded on November 9, 1997 by the Missionary Baptist Church of Haiti.

Location: La Romana, Dominican Republic

- Sponsors the Health Promoters
- Ground transport
- Interpreters and staff to support DR BHI activities on the bateys

Success: Maintaining Health Promoter program and Reduced Co-Pay Evenings

Challenges: Following up with high-risk patients



Activities performed

- Collaborated with local partners in hypertension management
- Engaged with community health "promoters"
- Learned from local professionals about delivering culturally appropriate care
- Reflected on global health ethics

Activities performed

- The DRBHI is moving toward a sustainable model of population-based global health
- Our trip contributed to:
 - o Developing relationships with local stakeholders
 - o Working towards improved follow-up care for Batey residents
