

SUGGESTED INCOMING STUDENT TIMELINE

1 JANUARY - MARCH

APPLY FOR FINANCIAL AID

- Complete the FAFSA. UMass Chan FAFSA School Code is G09756.
 - This is for **everyone applying for financial aid** (loans - federal, institutional, private) and gift aid (grants, scholarships, tuition waivers). FAFSA is based on student financial information.
- Complete CSS Profile. UMass Chan CSS Profile Code is 3936.
 - This is **ONLY** for people applying for **institutional need-based grant and scholarship funding**.
 - If you only plan to apply for student loans (federal or private) you should not submit the CSS Profile.
 - CSS Profile is based on parent and student financial information.

SET UP NET PARTNER

- Once FAFSA has been completed and the school has received it (~1-3 business days) then you can log into Net Partner on the UMass Chan Financial Aid website and create your profile **using the email address you provided on your FAFSA**.
- Complete financial aid application under "Applications" tab on Net Partner.
- Check "Documents" tab in Net Partner and upload the required documents (may include parents' signed federal tax return from two years prior and W2 forms). Additional documents may be listed.

2 MID MARCH

REVIEW AWARD

- Financial aid offer notifications sent by email and listed on the "Financial Aid Offer" tab of your Net Partner account.

3 JUNE - JULY

- Apply for a private loan if additional financial aid is needed. More information can be found on the UMass Chan Financial Aid office website to compare lenders.
- If you are using federal loans, this is a good time to complete Entrance Counseling and Direct Loan Master Promissory Note at studentaid.gov.

4 AUGUST

- Fall disbursement begins mid-August.
- Students needing additional funding may contact the financial aid office for options. This can be done at any point in the semester.
- Once classes begin you should be logging into NetPartner using your UMass Chan email address

5 OCTOBER

- FAFSA for next academic year opens. There is no rush, the ideal timeline is to complete it January-March. **Deadline is June 1.**

6 JANUARY

- Spring disbursement begins mid-January.
- M1s need to be **mindful** of the budget as spring lasts longer than the fall:
 - Fall disbursement is planned to last **five months** (August - January).
 - Spring disbursement is planned to last **eight months** (January-August).

- **This is a suggested timeline.** It is **never** too late to apply to financial aid but keep in mind that by applying late you may not be in the running for need-based aid. More details on refund timeline [here](#).
