CAMPUS SAFETY AND CRIME STATISTICS

The University of Massachusetts Medical School is concerned with the safety of its students, staff, faculty, guests and visitors. We accept the responsibility to employ security measures and law enforcement practices to help provide the UMMS community with a safe, secure environment in which to work and pursue academic goals.

The UMMS DPS prepares a report in compliance with the Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Crime Statistics Act. This report includes statistics for the previous three reporting years concerning reported crimes that occurred on campus; in certain off-campus buildings or property owned or controlled by UMMS; and on public property within, or immediately adjacent to and accessible from the campus. This report also includes institutional policies concerning campus security, such as policies concerning alcohol and drug use, crime prevention, the reporting of crimes, sexual assault, and other matters.

You can review the most recent <u>Campus Security Annual Report</u> available. This report is prepared in cooperation with local law enforcement agencies and campus administrators. Each entity provides updated information on their educational efforts and programs to comply with the Clery Act. Campus crime, arrest and referral statistics include those reported to the UMMMS DPS, designated campus security authorities and local law enforcement agencies.

Each year, notification about how to access the Annual Security Report is made to all enrolled students, faculty and staff. All prospective employees and students may also obtain a copy from the UMMS DPS.
