



## Post Graduate Certificate Adult-Gerontology Acute Care Nurse Practitioner



This is an 18 credit Post Graduate Certificate that can be completed in two semesters full time. Courses are offered in a hybrid format with flexible course delivery with combination of online and face to face. Students complete 540 clinical hours in an acute care setting with adults and older adult Patients. Graduates are eligible to sit for Adult Gerontology Acute Care NP certification exam given by AACN or ANCC upon successful completion of the program. Applicants must be practicing NPs who are certified as Adult, Adult Gerontology Primary Care, or Family NPs. A review of previous coursework prior to admission will be done to ensure eligibility for certification.
