

UMass Medical School Graduate School of Nursing in Worcester, MA is looking for instructors for our incoming Graduate Entry Program students this fall.

Instructors must have an active MA nursing license, a BSN or MSN, and five years' experience as a nurse to be eligible to teach. Instructors work with groups of 5 students across two eight-hour shifts for the fall semester, which starts on 9/7/21 and ends on 12/17/21. (That's the plan right now. COVID restrictions may alter the size of the clinical group. If it were to change the group size would be smaller.)

Newly hired instructors are required to attend the Annual Instructor Orientation on the morning of August 16th. Since the start of the pandemic, this orientation has been conducted virtually via Webex. However, if you do not currently work for UMMHC or need to be re-certified in glucometer use and tying/untying quick-release knots this is done in-person. In-person skills sessions will be held in person after the Webex.

There is also an online portion of the UMMMC Faculty Orientation that is assigned in HealthStream, along with a Centralized Clinical Placement (CCP) orientation.
