

The total number of scientific journals launched in the last 10 years.



Welcome to Jane

Have you recently written a paper, but you're not sure to which journal you should submit it? Or maybe you want to find relevant articles to cite in your paper? Or are you an editor, and do you need to find reviewers for a particular paper? Jane can help!

Just enter the title and/or abstract of the paper in the box, and click on 'Find journals', 'Find authors' or 'Find Articles'. Jane will then compare your document to millions of documents in *PubMed* to find the best matching journals, authors or articles.

Keyword search

Instead of using a title or abstract, you can also search using a keyword search, similar to popular web search engines. Click <u>here</u> to search using keywords.

Beware of predatory journals

JANE relies on the data in PubMed, which can contain papers from predatory journals, and therefore these journals can appear in JANE's results. To help identify high-quality journals JANE now tags journals that are currently indexed in MEDLINE, and open access journals approved by the Directory of Open Access Journals (DOAJ).







Criteria for selecting a journal

Criteria	Considerations
Scope	Does your research fall within the scope of the journal? Is this a journal that is used by you, your mentors, or colleagues?
Audience	Who is your desired audience? International? Very specific research area?
Publication Types and Format	Some journals publish specific types of research and may not be appropriate if you have a specific manuscript type in mind.
Reputation	Published by a recognized publisher or society? Who are the editors/editorial board? Who has published in it? Impact factor?
Quality	Peer reviewed? Indexed in MEDLINE, Scopus or Web of Science? Do articles meet your standard for rigor and quality?
Editorial Policies	Word count restrictions? Allows authors to comply with funder public access mandates? Posts statement of ethical practices?
Access	Does the journal allow for free access to their articles? What are the open access options and is there a fee?



Beware the "predatory publisher"

"... the name most frequently used to describe a nebulous concept of research journal publishers who use unethical business practices, minimal or no peer review, or limited editorial oversight to publish articles that are below a minimally accepted standard of quality."

Predatory publishing tactics

- Aggressively soliciting article submissions;
- Promising rapid publication;
- Eliminating or automating peer review;
- Not following reporting or publication guidelines (CONSORT, COPE);
- Not submitting content to major indexing and abstracting databases;
- Cloaking APCs until the article has been published;
- Misrepresenting editorial board;
- Refusing to withdraw a manuscript;
- Harassing authors to submit payment.

Characteristics of predatory publishers

- Overly broad scope (includes biomedical and non-biomedical subjects)
- Spelling and grammatical errors on website
- Poor quality images
- Homepage language targets authors
- Index Copernicus Value is promoted as a quality indicator
- Lack of information about manuscript handling
- Accepts or requests manuscripts by email

- Rapid publication is promised
- ♦ No retraction policy
- No information on whether or how content will be archived
- ♦ Low article processing charges
- Journal retains copyright or does not mention copyright
- Non-professional contact email address (e.g., @gmail.com or @yahoo.com)





- The Open Access model does not change or impact the submission, peer-review, or editorial processes for journals.
- There are high impact open access journals in a wide range of disciplines, e.g. BMJ, PLOS Medicine, BMC Medicine, Annals of Family Medicine, Journal of the American Board of Family Medicine, BMC Family Practice
- "Our findings indicate that the methodological quality of studies published in OA and non-OA journals, as well as the quality of reporting, are comparable."
- Not all Open Access journals charge article processing charges.

Are you submitting your research to a trusted journal? Is it the right journal for your work?

- More research is being published worldwide.
- New journals are launched each week.
- Stories of publisher malpractice and deception are also on the rise.
- It can be challenging to find up-to-date guidance when choosing where to publish.

How can you be sure the journal you are considering is the right journal for your research?



Reference this list for your chosen journal to check if it is trusted.

- Do you or your colleagues know the journal?
- Have you read any articles in the journal before?
- Is it easy to discover the latest papers in the journal?
- Can you easily identify and contact the publisher?
- Is the publisher name clearly displayed on the journal website?
- Can you contact the publisher by telephone, email, and post?
- Is the journal clear about the type of peer review it uses?
- Are articles indexed in services that you use?
- Is it clear what fees will be charged?
- Does the journal site explain what these fees are for and when they will be charged?
- Do you recognise the editorial board?
- Have you heard of the editorial board members?
- Do the editorial board mention the journal on their own websites?
- Is the publisher a member of a recognized industry initiative?
- Do they belong to the Committee on Publication Ethics (COPE)?
- If the journal is open access, is it listed in the <u>Directory of Open Access</u> <u>Journals (DOAJ)</u>?
- If the journal is open access, does the publisher belong to the <u>Open Access Scholarly Publishers' Association (OASPA)</u>?
- Is the journal hosted on one of INASP's <u>Journals Online</u> platforms (for journals published in Bangladesh, Nepal, Sri Lanka, Central America and Mongolia) or on <u>African Journals</u> <u>Online</u> (AJOL, for African journals)?
- Is the publisher a member of another trade association?



If you can answer 'yes' to most or all of the questions on the list.

Complete the check list and submit your article only if you are happy you can answer 'yes' to most or all of the questions.

- You need to be confident your chosen journal will have a suitable profile among your peers to enhance your reputation and your chance of gaining citations.
- Publishing in the right journal for your research will raise your professional profile, and help you progress in your career.
- Your paper should be indexed or archived and be easily discoverable.
- You should expect a professional publishing experience where your work is reviewed and edited.
- Only then should you submit your article.


9 Signs that a Conference is Fake

- 1. The conference has an overly ambitious title.
- 2. The technical program is very broad.
- 3. The language on the conference website is ... off.
- 4. Renowned organizations are sponsoring a low-profile conference.
- 5. The organizer's contact details are missing or aren't quite right.
- 6. Another conference with a suspiciously similar name already exists
- 7. The conference or its organizers have known associates.
- 8. The organizers are charging higher-than-normal fees.
- 9. The conference is unusually frequent.

Why Think. Check. Attend.

Think. Check. Attend. is an initiative that aims to guide and assist researchers and scholars to judge the legitimacy and academic credentials of conferences in order to help them decide whether to or not attend the same. Nowadays, the scholarly community faces an increasing number of invitations to present at or attend conferences. Some of these are respectable, academic events, while others are misleading, exaggerated or even fake. Think. Check. Attend. provides guidelines that help researchers to differentiate between an authentic conference and the one they should avoid. In this initiative, we help scholars to recognise the characteristics of a trusted conference to attend and submit their abstracts through a number of steps and a check list. Simply follow these steps and you will rest assured that you attend only the most appropriate conferences.

Check These



This check list provides guidance on trusting a conference to attend and present your research.

Organizers & Sponsors

- · Are you aware of the society or the association organizing this conference?
- · Can you easily identify the venue of the conference?
- Is it the first time that this conference is being held?
- Have you or your colleagues attended this conference before?
- Is it clear what fees will be charged (conference fee, registration fees, ..., etc.) and would these be waived if you are accepted as a speaker?
- · Are any of the sponsors involved in the conference?
- Are you aware of any of them, especially with industry-related fields such as Engineering & Biomedical research?
- Did you check the conference website? Is all the information (such as the attendance fees, submission date, conference date, editorial committee, program details and venue) presented in a proper way?
- · Have you read any papers from this conference proceedings before?

Agenda & Editorial Committee

- Is there a clear information about the timeline and the agenda for the conference?
- Do the scope and objectives of the conference fit your field and core interest or not?
- · Have you heard of the Keynote speakers?
- . Is the Editorial Committee listed on the website?
- · Have you heard of the Editorial Committee members before?
- Is the Committee clear about the editorial control over presentations and the type of peer-review it uses?

Conference Proceedings

- Is the Organizing Committee clear about where the proceedings will be published?
- Does the conference make it clear which indexing services it can guarantee the published proceedings and to which indexers will it submit the proceedings for evaluation?
- Is the publisher of the proceedings a member of a recognized industry initiative such as COPE, DOAJ. OASPA?


- · Attending the right conference will give you the opportunity to maintain your awareness of the latest updates and improvements in your field.
