

Respondus LockDown Browser

Installing/Updating Lockdown Browser

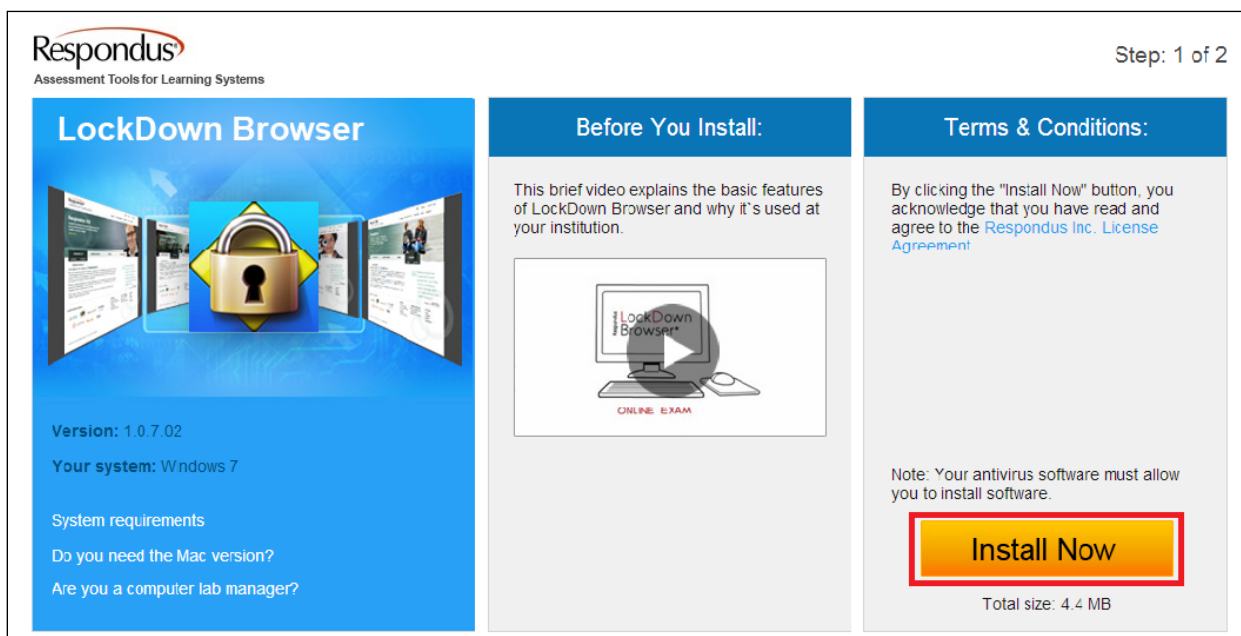
Respondus LockDown Browser is a customized, secure browser that increases the security of online testing in learning management systems like Blackboard. It is a stand-alone application that must be installed on each computer being used to take an online test.

Installation

Follow the instructions below to install the Windows or Mac version of Respondus LockDown Browser.

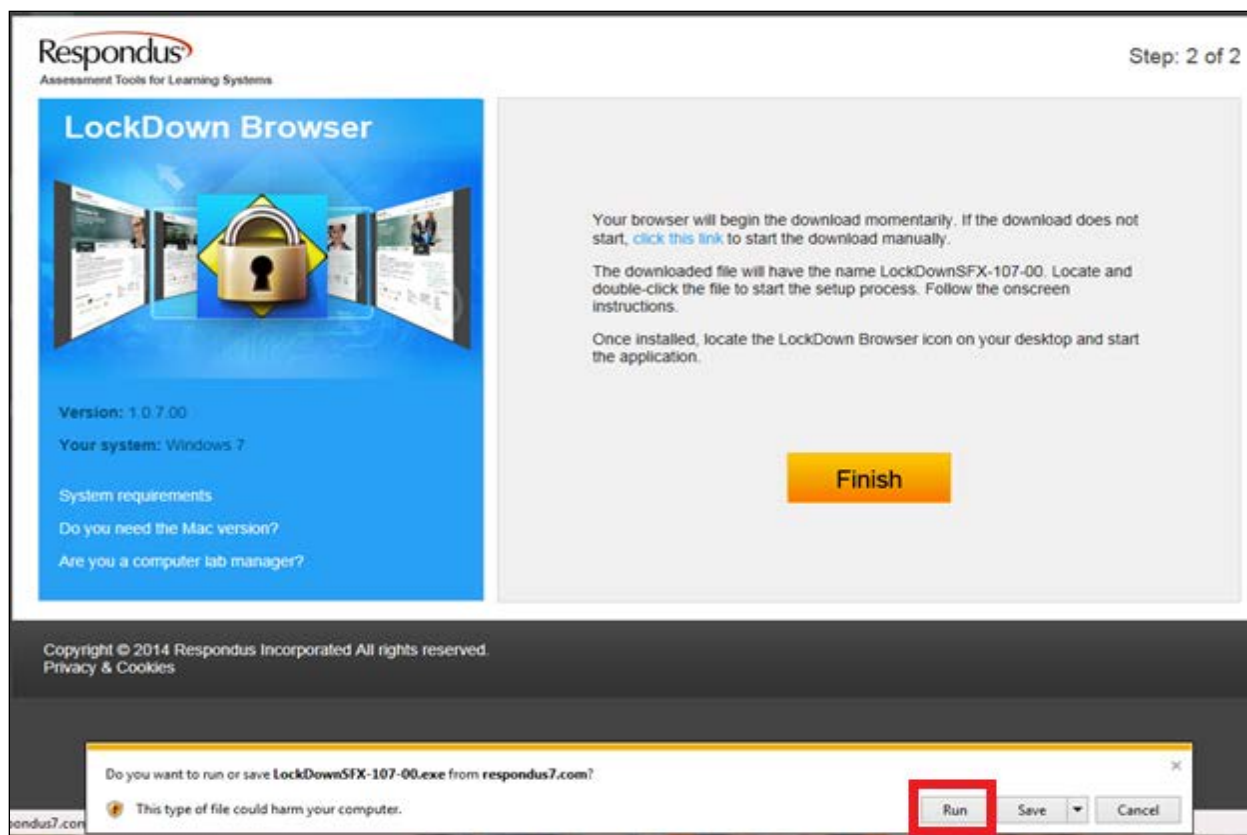
Note: If you already have LockDown Browser installed on your computer but need to check for an update, please see the **Updating to the Latest Version** section below.

1. Click on the **UMMS LockDown Browser Installer** link to begin the **Respondus LockDown Browser** download process: <http://www.respondus.com/lockdown/information.pl?ID=948736164>.
2. On the **Respondus LockDown Browser Installation** page, click **Install Now**.



3. You will be prompted to **Run** or **Save** an .exe file (Windows) or .zip file (Mac). Click **Run** (Windows) or double-click the .pkg file (Mac), and follow the prompts to install LockDown Browser.

Note: The **Run** option may function differently depending on the platform and browser you are using.



4. Click the **Finish** button to complete the installation. Be sure to close the installation window after the software has been installed.

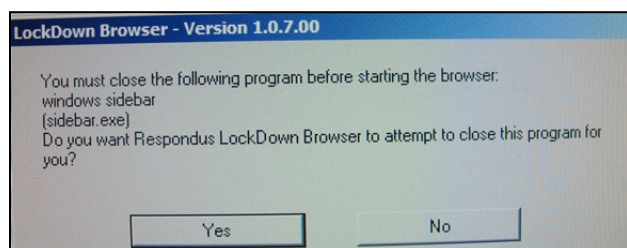
Updating to the Latest Version

You should be automatically prompted to check for Respondus LockDown Browser updates once you have it installed. To check for the latest version manually, follow these steps:

1. Start the Respondus LockDown Browser application. The icon will be located on your desktop after installation.

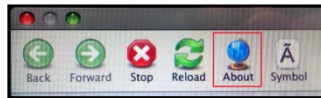


Note: All screens must be closed before the lockdown browser will open. Should you receive the following

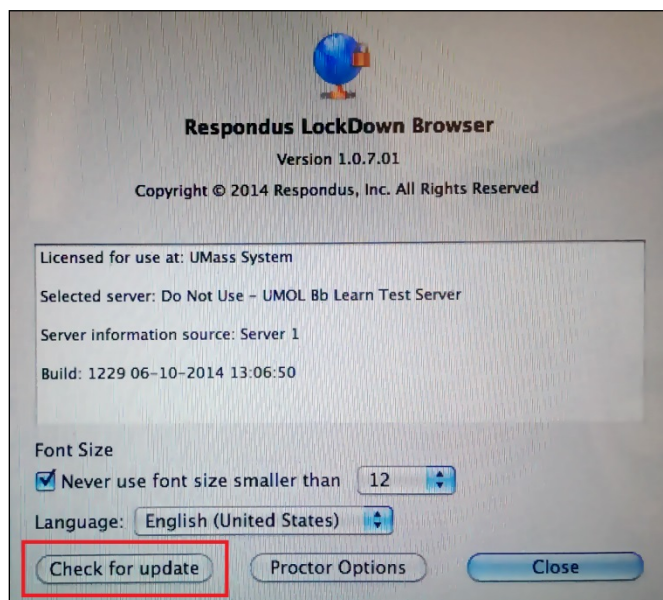
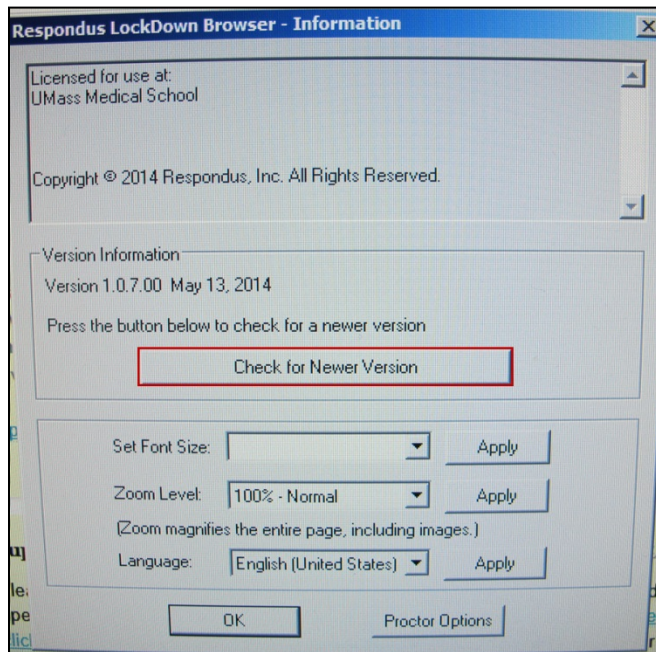


message, close out of all open windows and try again.

2. Select **i** from the toolbar (Windows) or **About** (Mac).



3. Select **Check for Newer Version** (PC) or **Check for update** (Mac).



4. Follow the on-screen instructions to download and run the update.
