Call for Nominations Guidelines

The nominee must be:

- A part-time or full-time Medical School women faculty member.
- A faculty member for a minimum of three years (with the exception of the Early Career Achievement Award).
- Previous award recipients are not eligible for an award in the same category but are eligible for other categories.

A personal statement (approximately 500 words) should be submitted about why you believe the nominee is worthy of the award. Please include the **nominee's** name, department/division, and specific award for which you are submitting the nomination. Be sure to include **your** name, department/ division, phone extension and/or email. Thank you.

Categories

SARAH STONE EXCELLENCE IN EDUCATION AWARD

This award is presented to a woman faculty member who has made exceptional contributions in education and/or curriculum development.

WOMEN IN SCIENCE AND HEALTH ACHIEVEMENTS AWARD

This award is presented to a woman faculty member who has made exceptional contributions to the basic or clinical sciences in medicine.

EARLY CAREER ACHIEVEMENT IN SCIENCE AND HEALTH AWARD

This award is presented to a woman junior faculty member (instructor or assistant professor) whose accomplishments show great promise in the areas of basic or clinical sciences in medicine.

EXCELLENCE IN CLINICAL SERVICE AWARD

This award is presented to a woman faculty member who has made exceptional contributions to patient care in the UMass and/or Worcester community.

OUTSTANDING MENTORING TO WOMEN FACULTY AWARD

This award is presented to a leader (male or female) who has provided strong mentoring and support to women faculty.

OUTSTANDING COMMUNITY SERVICE AWARD

This award is presented to a woman faculty member who best exemplifies outstanding community service to the UMass and/or Worcester community outside normal job duties.
