

Nominations Committee Process

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Vice Provost for Faculty Affairs



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The Nominations Committee oversees the process in which faculty populate Standing Committees

Duties: considers and votes on nominations for appointments; may also nominate individuals for appointments; finalizes a slate of candidates for approval by Executive Council and/or vote by the Faculty-at-Large.

Voting Membership:

- 3 members elected by the Executive Council
- 4 members elected by the Faculty Council
- Chair of the Student Government Alliance
