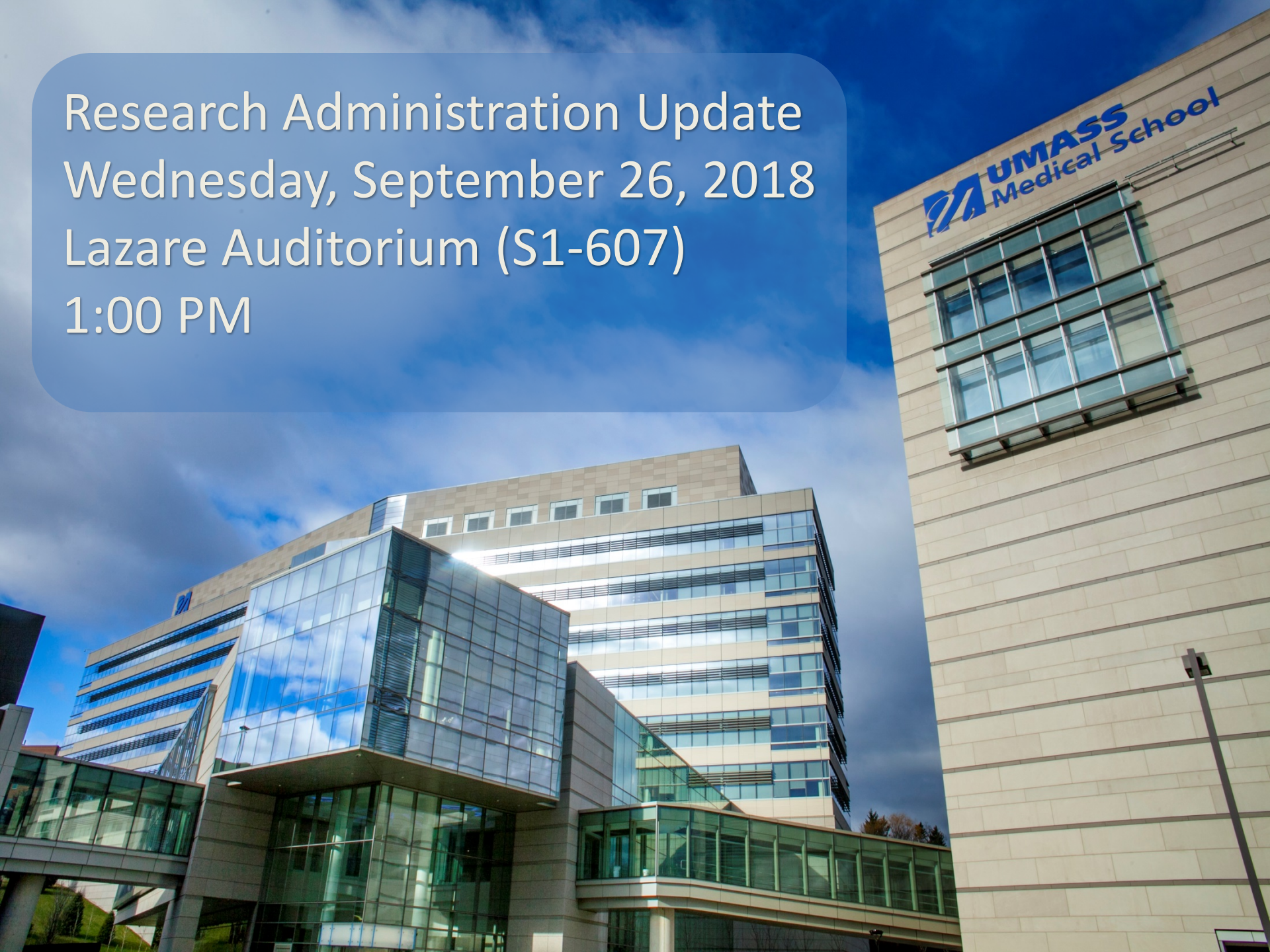
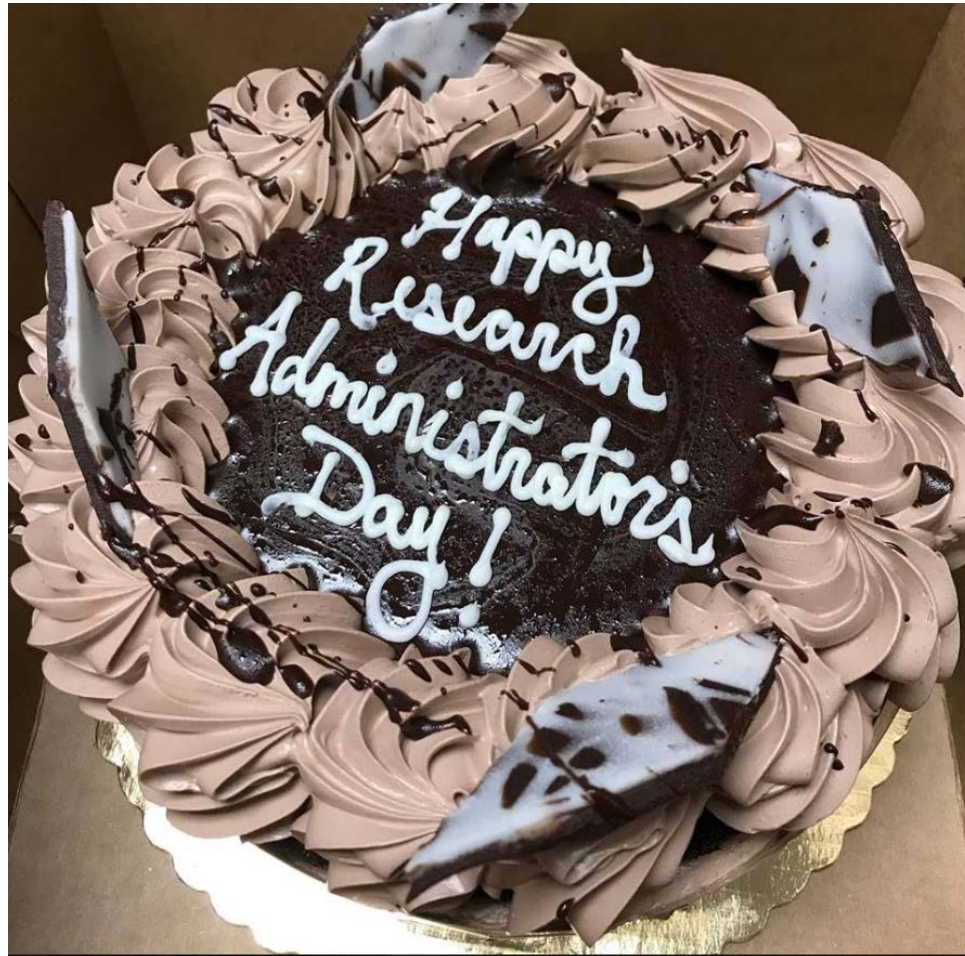

Export and Espionage

China - #1 security concern (Russia, N. Korea)

- Stealing, hacking.
- Insider threat is the number 1 greatest concern.
 - 53% of industry had insider threats in 2017.
 - Responsible for 80% of stolen data.

Dark Web

- Anonymizing browser.
- Spam frequently comes from the dark web.

NIH Synchronizes Institutional Delegations

NIH has modified the Interim and Final RPPR module within eRA Commons to automatically incorporate the same delegation options available to institutions within the annual RPPR.

Specifically, a PD/PI may delegate initiation of any type of RPPR, including the Interim and Final RPPR, to a program assistant.

Allows Decimals in Effort Reporting Field

NIH has changed its RPPR format to allow effort being reported to include decimals.

Until now, the system only allowed whole numbers and rounded up or down accordingly.

PD/PIs contributing 20% effort or 2.4 calendar months, can now be entered accordingly. Previous system feature rounded effort down to 2 calendar months.

Effort Reporting on the Final RPPR

Section D.1. Individuals who worked on the project:

Should this section report on the individuals/staff from the past year of the project period or the whole project?

This section should report on the individuals/staff that worked on the project *during the last budget period* minus any approved no-cost extensions.
