Notes:

1. Residents will rotate through Boston Children's Hospital for 6 blocks, 3 months as a PGY2 and 3 months as a PGY3.

2. Four weeks of total vacation can be taken during the year, 1 week at a time with 6 months notice and approval by the program director and coordinator.

3. PGY1 consists of 13 blocks 4 weeks long; PGY2-5 consists of 12 blocks comprised of 1 calendar month each.

4. Acute Care Surgery service covering Colorectal, Thoracic, ENT, Surgical Oncology, and General Surgery.

5. Research: During the PGY-3 and PGY-4 years, residents will have the option of doing basic or clinical research, or focused clinical training and scholarship in an area of interest.

6. Residents on research rotations will be used to cover cases with high educational value and will participate in the call rotation.

7. PRS Facial Trauma: The goal of the rotation is to expose residents to maxillofacial trauma patient evaluation and surgical cases.

8. Sites 1,2,3 are owned and operated by the primary participating site.
