Self-pay Services Include:

- Comprehensive Evaluations for Neurodevelopmental and Complex Psychiatric Disorders
 - Second opinion/consultation for diagnostic clarification and treatment recommendations
 - Diagnoses, including autism and Fragile X, and complex psychiatric disorders, such as mood and psychotic disorders
- Occupational Therapy and Speech-language Therapy

Personalized therapy services include:

- Review of Individual Education Plan (IEP) and records
- Attend school/program meetings
- School and home observations
- Family and/or provider training
