With only two small reservations noted for mental health (1 incomplete info request and 1 latching issue for stairwell door), this visit was described as “the best survey we’ve done across all services”! The attached UMMMC FY2017 Priorities Scorecard was also circulated for information and posting. CHAIR ANNOUNCEMENTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>Barbara Fisher, UMMHC Senior Vice President of Operations</b> – Ms. Fisher noted hospital leadership appreciation to all for patience and assistance provided during the recent transcription service issues. She also outlined updated EPIC training and other go-live deadlines and available resources. Here are a few key facts for easy reference:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- EPIC training is required for all faculty, clinicians, resident supervisors, and administrative staff providing clinical support.</li><li>- It is critical all go to E-Learning 4U immediately to review your assigned training needs and to register for required courses (200 level, 300 level, and 100 level courses). (Suggest using Firefox rather than Internet Explorer for more efficient training accessibility.)</li><li>- Soft Go-Live is scheduled for early September with conversion of legacy system to EPIC. Weekend of September 9-10 is reserved for outpatient appointment conversion to new EPIC system</li><li>- Command Centers will be available for IT and other key areas of concern to provide all employees with assistance during go-live.</li><li>- Newly established formal rounding system have been scheduled for Fridays 1:00-3:00p for UMMHC executive interactive visits and discussions with staff and clinicians.</li></ul></li><li>• <b>Mr. G. Eric Carpenter, new Chief Executive Officer, Worcester Recovery Center &amp; Hospital</b> – In his new role as CEO for WRCH, Mr. Carpenter joined today's meeting to provide introductory remarks and a brief overview of WRCH and its programs, services, bed count, FTE positions, population served, challenges, and goals for the future. His plan is to bring to his new role lessons learned in his previous experience to maintain, improve, and advance programs at Worcester Center &amp; Hospital.</li><li>• <b>EPIC</b> – In f/u to last week's <i>Psychiatry Communication</i> reminder, it is critical anyone providing clinical services or clinical admin/research support to go online to E-Learning 4U immediately to: 1) confirm your EPIC training assignment, 2) register to attend all "200" level courses and "300" level courses, and 3) complete pre-course "100" level on-line course as assigned.
