Chair's Welcome & Announcements	<p><i>Dr. Sheldon Benjamin, opened today's his inaugural meeting as Interim Chair of Psychiatry with welcoming remarks and announcements noted on the following pages. Featured Presentations	<p><i>Please be sure to note the important changes being made to these monthly meetings.</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Future department meeting ideas/interactive feedback session results are noted below. Many thanks to the 97 attendees who participated in the polling process. 36% of attendees were administration and financial staff, 31% were physician faculty, 17% were psychologists, and 14% were trainees. 39% had been in the department for 4 years or less and 4% had been here 30 years or more! <p>We learned that a number of department members work here because of the department's mission, culture or a desire to give back to the community.</p> <p>61% of attendees felt connected to the departments mission but 9% did not (the rest were in between).</p> <p>69% felt supported by their boss and/or department leadership</p> <p>The majority were in favor of alternating full department with faculty only meetings SEE MEETING SCHEDULE AT END OF MINUTES-PLEASE MARK YOUR CALENDARS NOW</p> <p>Department members felt the MOST strongly about lunch. Only 3% of respondents said that lunch did not affect their attendance at department meetings. 	<p>About 60% said they come to meetings to connect with colleagues, learn about programs, accomplishments, awards etc and about 53% felt they were getting all they wanted from meetings.</p> <p>A slight majority of attendees indicated a desire to receive meeting minutes—We are sending these on a trial basis to see if they are helpful. Please email Denise if you find these minutes helpful.</p> <p>We asked the department whether they might be interested in an alternative holiday celebration this December. 80% of those in attendance said they would either possibly or definitely like to attend a 7th floor potluck “block party” on Wednesday 12/20/17 from 4-6 PM. <i>Stay tuned for details.</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Psychiatry Grand Rounds – --- The 2016-2017 lecture season ended on Thursday, June 8th with speaker, Dr. Larry Davidson (<i>What's new about recovery?</i>). The new 2017-2018 season begins on September 14th with a presentation by Interim Chair, Dr. Sheldon Benjamin. Please mark your calendars (12:00-1:00p). Of those present at the department meeting, about 30% indicated that they attend grand rounds regularly. Dr. Benjamin requests increased faculty support of our weekly Psychiatry Grand Rounds by 1) discouraging the scheduling of other meetings during Thursday 12-1 Psych Grand Rounds time and 2) adding the weekly presentations to your schedule. Many thanks to Dr. Tony Rothschild and the planning committee who have put together an excellent speaker line-up for the new season.
