

Dr. Jordan Eisenstock is a board certified neurologist and psychiatrist, and an Assistant Professor of Neurology and Psychiatry at UMass Medical School in Worcester, MA. Among his many varied responsibilities, Jordan leads Quality Improvement for the UMass Department of Psychiatry. He also serves as Director of Neurorehabilitation at Fairlawn Rehabilitation Hospital (a joint venture with UMass Memorial Health Care and HealthSouth Corporation). He is on the UMass Memorial Accountable Care Organization, Inc. Board of Trustees, and has served on the neurology steering committee for the National Quality Forum in Washington, DC, and on an examination committee for the American Board of Psychiatry and Neurology in Chicago, IL. In addition, Jordan is the President and Founding Partner for Community Neuroscience Services (Westborough, MA), a comprehensive neurology practice dedicated to providing holistic, multi-disciplinary care.

As a clinician, Dr. Eisenstock specializes in treating a broad array of neurologic conditions, but has a particular interest in sports-related concussion. His multi-disciplinary approach is gleaned from diverse medical, academic and business experience. Since 2008 Jordan has worked at UMass as an attending neurologist and neuropsychiatrist and enjoys teaching residents, fellows, and medical students participating in the same academic programs that he once attended as a medical trainee.
