All boxes on the 2nd page must be completed in full for your application to be considered.
Please note availability for the funding is limited.

ELIGIBILITY

- Applicant must submit an abstract as first/presenting author to RNATx2021 by the **March 12, 2021** abstract submission deadline.
- International applicants are welcome.
- Applicant must be an early career investigator: including students, postdocs and PIs within the first 3 years of initialing their own lab.
- *Applications must be from populations that have been shown to be underrepresented in biomedical research, such as:*
 - Underrepresented racial and ethnic groups: African American/Black, Hispanic/Latino, Native American/Alaska Native, or Hawaiian Native/Natives of the U.S. Pacific Islands, or;
 - Individuals with disabilities: defined as those with a physical or mental impairment that substantially limits one or more major life activities, as described in the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, or;
 - Individuals from disadvantaged/underserved backgrounds: defined as individuals from an economically disadvantaged background, first generation college graduates, or individuals from challenging social, cultural or educational background, or;
 - Identify as a female in the biological workforce

REQUIRED EVENT PARTICIPATION

Award recipients are required to participate fully in the following events. Details will be provided with award notification.

- Career Workshop and Networking Reception on Wednesday, June 23, 2021
- Poster or Oral Presentation of submitted abstract during meetings, Thursday and Friday, June 23-25, 2021.
