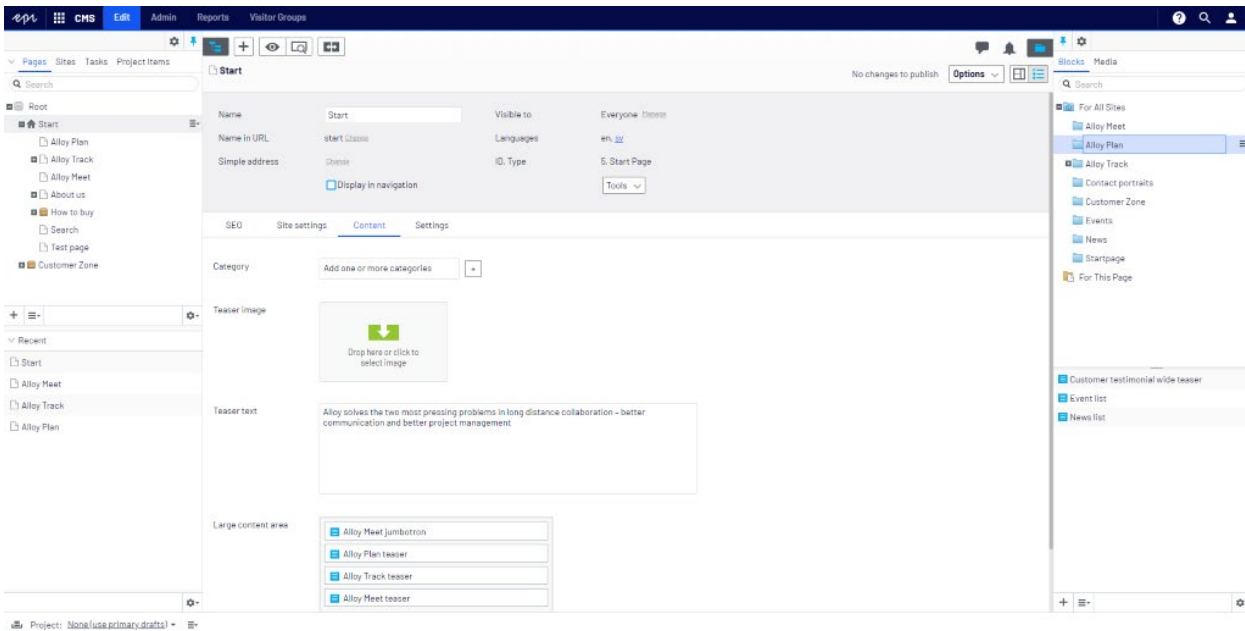

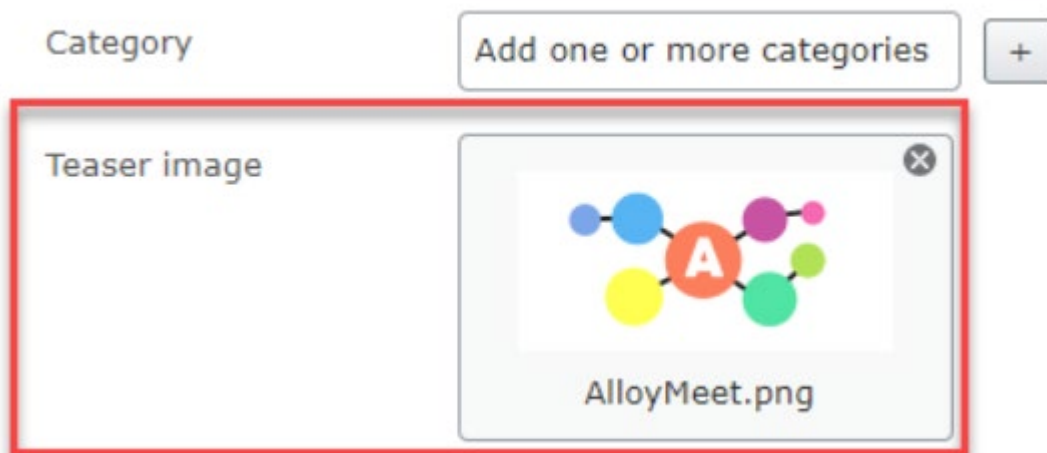

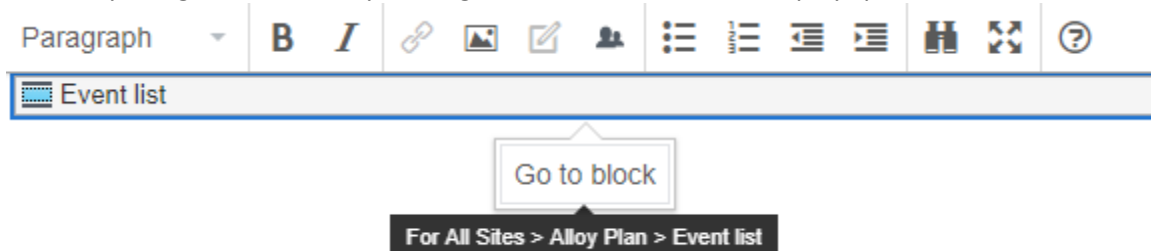

- Content status for blocks (ex: expired)
- **Images**
 - Can drag and drop an image directly from local computer now
 - Image property now shows a thumbnail of the image in properties view.

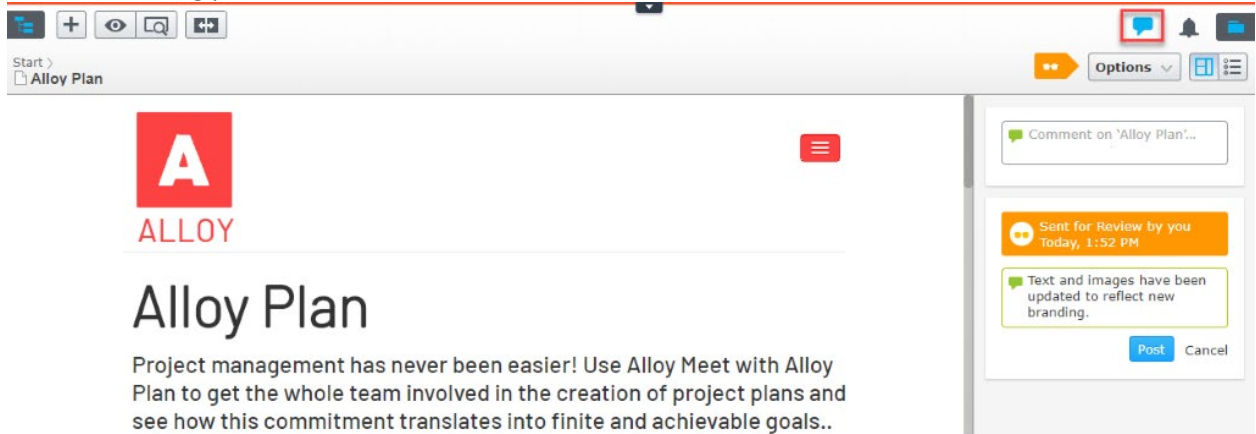


- **Updates to trash**
 - View information about deleted content (content id, content type name, and original location) by hovering over the item
 - Permanently delete individual items from trash
- **TinyMCE WYSIWYG editor**
 - easily navigate to blocks by clicking a "Go to Block" button, displays path of where block is located



- Drag and drop images directly in content, no need to drag and drop to media. Image will be added to "For this page" container

- Add link to FIGURE tag
- **Add comments on a content item in the editing UI**
 - To make content collaboration and communication easier, editors can add and view comments on content items, even if they are not associated with a project. The commenting functionality is accessed via a new commenting pane in the user interface. Toggle the pane with a toolbar button (). See also Ben McKernan's blog post, [Comments for content](#).



- **Change approval - [Support for 4-eyes approval](#)**
 - By selecting the Prevent users from approving their own changes check box, the person who made a change is not allowed to approve, even if that person is assigned as an approver.

New Add-ons and packages

These are new add-ons. These are not included in the upgrade, they are products developed outside of Episerver CMS. It is functionality we can review and include in future story if we wish to include in our CMS.

New add-on: [Delivra](#)

A new add-on, Episerver Marketing Automation connector for Delivra, which provides support for Delivra and includes all functionality of other MAI connectors.

[Episerver Languages](#)

Episerver Languages now uses Microsoft translation API version 3; version 2 is obsolete on April 30, 2019 so previous versions of Episerver Languages may not work.

[Mogul.SEO.Manager.Package 5.2.5.0](#)

- Added Download buttons to 404 and 410 admin pages. Through those buttons, users can download all 404 or 410 URLs.
- The pages tree now shows pages in fallback languages as well as the master language.
- You can disable default language redirection.
- On the Settings admin page, on the Export/Import tab, you see a table with numbers of our URLs. Also, on the start admin page, you see the numbers of all URLs in the database.

Episerver Advance (part of Personalization project)

Content recommendations using the Strategy container block. The Strategy Container block retrieves content recommendation data from the Advance API and displays content suggestions based on a strategy, such as popular content or what other users read. See also: Episerver Strategy container block.

Episerver Tracking

The new package EPiServer.Session 1.0.0 provides a SessionId for Episerver tracking services, stored in the client's browser cookie. The default and maximum duration is 1800 seconds (30 minutes), which you can modify. See also the [EPiServer.Session](#) topic.
